**Meditation:** The story of Moses' mountain ascent to receive God's commandments is juxtaposed with the story of Jesus' mountain ascent when he was transfigured in the midst of his disciples. The presence of Moses and Elijah on the mountain with Jesus emphasizes his continuity with the ongoing story of God's journey with the people of God. Images of light, of the shining glory of God, suffuse today's readings. As Jesus is transfigured, His face shining like the sun, we see a new world in which God establishes justice and righteousness for all.

**The Transfiguration**

**17** After six days Jesus took with him Peter, James and John the brother of James, and led them up a high mountain by themselves. **2** There he was transfigured before them. His face shone like the sun, and his clothes became as white as the light. **3** Just then there appeared before them Moses and Elijah, talking with Jesus.




